You will use this virtual workshop to practice the **basics of scientific inquiry** (observation, inference, evidence, and classification) using **authentic archaeological data**. You will learn first hand how to help your students apply archaeological concepts as they investigate a shelter using **primary data** sources such as maps, artifact illustrations, historic photographs and oral histories. By using this curriculum you will fulfill many **Common Core State Standards** requirements in social studies, English Language Arts, and math (CCSS alignments). Your students discover archaeology and history through engaging **hands-on activities**.

Participants in this course will receive online access to professional development, two graduate credits, a complete curriculum guide, access to a database of 16 regional shelter investigations, and instructions for assembling your own classroom materials during the course.
